









## Three Bridges Oak Preserve Fuels Reduction Project

The Upper Salinas-Las Tablas Resource Conservation District (USLTRCD) is partnering with the Atascadero Land Preservation Society, the Atascadero Fire Department, San Luis Obispo County Firesafe Council and CALFIRE to implement a fuels reduction project at Three Bridges Oak Preserve. More information on this collaborative project is listed below.



- Project's goals include enhancement of forest health and mitigation of wildfire risks to the community
- Treatments will focus on reducing dead vegetation and some live vegetation that serves as wildfire fuel both in the preserve and along roadways
- Treatment units are strategically located near homes and in high fire hazard severity zones
- Fuels reduction crews will use chainsaws and tracked chippers to disperse material. The work will be noisy; however noise ordinances will be adhered to
- The work will begin no sooner than April 14<sup>th</sup>. Crews are expected to take 7-9 days to complete the project
- To ensure the protection of wildlife, certified biologists will be present on-site periodically throughout the project's duration
- Funding for this project provided by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection's
  Wildfire Resiliency Program
